



## Dear Parishioners of St Mary's,

Now that the Fiscal Year 2022/23 has come to a close, it's a fitting time to give you an opportunity to take a closer look at our parish's overall financial health. Below is a document detailing our income and expenses. I would like to give perspective and highlight a few details. Due to your generosity, our parish's Sunday Collection for this fiscal year totaled \$220,152, up 1.1% from the previous fiscal year. By mindfully monitoring our expenses, we were able to put \$16,566 in savings. I would like to highlight two important funds and their purpose. PHP or Parishioners Helping Parishioners collected \$1,972 and directly supported parishioners experiencing financial difficulty. The Capital Improvement Fund collected \$13,550 and when needed, is used to help cover the cost of various maintenance projects. On behalf of our parish's Finance Council and our clergy, I thank you for sharing your TREASURE with our parish. Lastly, as you recall, our parish capital campaign was put on hold by the diocese because of their Growing Disciples initiative. We will visit this topic again when the planning phase for Growing Disciples concludes next summer.
